
Dear Mr. Taylor,

It has come to the attention of the Funny River Community Association Board, that an extremely serious ethics violation has been committed by Independent Prosecutor Clinton Campion for the Kenai Special Grand Jury investigating systemic corruption in the Alaska Judicial System.

In February 2012, Mr. Campion was working as Chief Assistant Attorney General and Lead Investigator during the investigation of Judge Investigator Marla Greenstein. Ms. Greenstein is one of the primary persons being investigated by the Kenai Special Grand Jury.

If Mr. Campion has not already recused himself from the position of Independent Prosecutor for this Kenai Special Grand Jury investigation, he should be removed immediately by your office. Additionally, we believe that the vetting and selection process for Independent Prosecutors be re-evaluated, to prevent a travesty of justice such as this with Mr. Campion from occurring in the future.
